1. Call to Order

Ch. Hooper called the meeting to order.

5. Public Comment: Animal Waste Lagoon, Feed Lot and Catch Pen location from adjoining property and residence. **Katrina & Michael Mintz**

Ms. Mintz stated they owned and resided on property adjacent to Vice Ch. Turk's property that was timber land when they purchased the property in 1993 but had since become a pasture where large amounts of manure have accumulated. She stated she felt Vice Turk was out of compliance with the Banks County Code and that there was a feed lot with a rubber pad in place at a location that did not meet required setbacks from the property line or a residence and that it had standing manure which created a bad odor. She stated there was a problem with rodents and insects. She asked that the

Commission Board recognize the noncompliance and to require compliance with local ordinances. She presented pictures of the pasture showing the manure and the proximity to their home.

Vice Ch. Turk addressed some of the alleged violations including the clarification that manure is not stored where cattle feed. He further stated he had asked compliance agencies to visit and inspect the property including NRCS, USDA, Banks County Code Enforcement and all stated the property was in compliance. He also read the definition of slander and stated he felt Ms. Mintz was slandering him as well as his daughters since they owned 9 of the 11 cows currently in the pasture.

Ch. Hooper stated he had checked with the appropriate agencies including Banks County Planning & Development, Banks County Code Enforcement, NRCS and the county attorney and all stated the property was in compliance with Banks County Code ordinances.

6. Digital Coverage Maps and Sites needed for Public Safety Infrastructure Deidra Moore

Ms. Moore presented a map showing the coverage deficiencies of the county which are primarily on the western portion. She asked for a 5th tower site to be located in the western portion of the county. She recommended leasing tower space at \$570/month for 5 years from Midamerica Towers, Inc. She asked for approval of the lease pending the county attorney's approval and asked that the Chairman be authorized to sign the agreement.
