**HYDRANT METERS:**

RENTAL FEE: \$2.00 PER DAY OR \$45.00 A MONTH

DEPOSIT REQUIRED: \$1,200.00 for NON-LOCAL CUSTOMERS (CHECK ONLY, refunded with returned, undamaged meter)  
(Local meaning business location and business license issued in Banks County)

RATE: \$8.75 PER THOUSAND, for every gallon recorded by hydrant meter.

**NOTES:**

- DEVELOPER IS REQUIRED TO FURNISH AND INSTALL ALL TAPS AND METERS FOR COMMERCIAL WATER AND SEWER SERVICES. WORK IS TO BE INSPECTED AND APPROVED BY BANKS COUNTY UTILITIES.
- TAP FEES FOR ALL METERS GREATER THAN 8" SHALL BE CALCULATED BY THE COUNTY ENGINEER, BASED ON USAGE AND CALCULATED TO RESIDENTIAL USE (ERU) OF 350 GPD
- FOR MASTER METERS SERVING MORE THAN ONE UNIT, THE FEE SHALL BE THE LARGER OF THE RATE SHOWN OR EQUIVALENT OF ¾" TAP FOR EACH UNIT SERVED BY SUCH METER.
