RATE: \$8.75 PER THOUSAND, for every gallon recorded by hydrant meter.

NOTES:

- 1. DEVELOPER IS REQUIRED TO FURNISH AND INSTALL ALL TAPS AND METERS FOR COMMERCIAL WATER AND SEWER SERVICES. WORK IS TO BE INSPECTED AND APPROVED BY BANKS COUNTY UTILITIES.
- 2. TAP FEES FOR ALL METERS GREATER THAN 8" SHALL BE CALCUALTED BY THE COUNTY ENGINEER, BASED ON USAGE AND CALCULATED TO RESIDENTUAL USE (ERU) OF 350 GPD
- 3. FOR MASTER METERS SERVIING MORE THAN ONE UNIT, THE FEE SHALL BE THE LARGER OF THE RATE SHOWN OR EQUIVALENT OF 3/4" TAP FOR EACH UNIT SERVVED BY SUCH METER.
