Poll Worker Application Banks County, Georgia

To be a Poll Worker in Banks County, you must:

- be a resident of Banks County;
- be 16 years of age or older;
- be able to read, write, and speak the English language;
- not have had a felony conviction for at least the last 10 years;
- not currently holding a public office or be a candidate for public office;
- not be a relative of an elected official who is on the ballot;
- attend a training session prior to each primary or election;
- report to your assigned polling place at 6:00 am on the day of the primary or election;
- remain at the polling place until the polls close and you have completed your assignment, which, typically should be by 8:00 pm, but there are times when your day may be longer.
